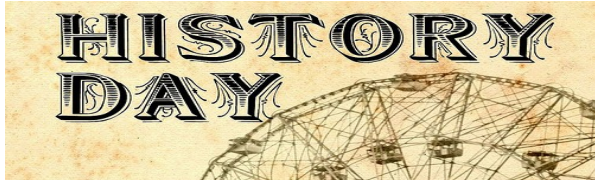

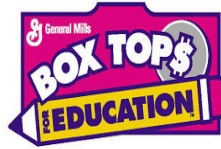
The items we need are:
